UPE Scholarship Awards to Student Members of the IEEE-CS – On behalf of the IEEE-CS, UPE is pleased to announce the names of the four recipients of the 2013 Scholarship Awards that are given to active student members of the IEEE-CS. Each scholarship recipient received a \$1,000 cash award from the IEEE-CS (with UPE funds that were donated to the IEEE-CS). 2013 UPE Scholarship Applications – UPE members who expect to be registered as students during the 2013-2014 school year are encouraged to submit their applications (submit *as pdf files to upe@acm.org*) for one of the UPE Scholarship Awards. These awards range from \$750 to \$1,500 and Council expects to present a minimum of 25 awards for the next school year. A copy of the scholarship application form is attached to this newsletter. You can also download a Word format of this application form from the UPE website. All application documents must be received by UPE no later than June 15, 2013. Awards will be announced on October 1, 2013.

UPE also provides funds for special scholarship awards to *student members of the ACM*. There are specific requirements and different deadlines for these awards. Students who are active members of a student chapter of the ACM should visit the ACM website for more information on these awards. You can also contact Ms. Samantha Goldberg at ACM Headquarters (local_activities@hq.acm.org) for additional details on these awards.
